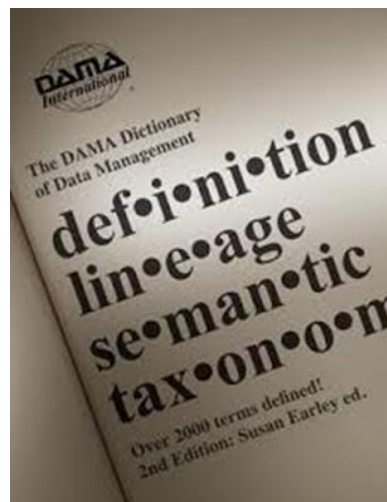

## The Data Management Body of Knowledge (DMBOK)

DAMA DMBOK defines a standard industry view of data management functions, terminology and best practices.

DMBOK provides a comprehensive framework for an organisation to develop and mature their data management function. The nature of data management remains the same across all organisations, though the scope and scale of implementation does vary.

The DMBOK is supported by the DAMA Dictionary of Data Management which contains over 2000 terms providing a common vocabulary for business and IT professionals working in data management.
